## NATIONAL ROAD INTERPRETIVE PANELS

**Greenfield-** On October 15, 2012, INRA Executive Director, Joe Frost, met with INDOT, Wayne County Highways, and the Hoosier Company at a pre-construction meeting in Greenfield. The meeting discussed the technical aspects of installation of the long awaited National Road Interpretive Panels.

From Richmond to Terre Haute, 15 interpretive panels will span the state. The panels will be located at unique locations along the Road. The Huddleston Farmhouse, the Whitewater State Park, and ISU are just a few locations. Each panel has two sides, one describes a unique story or feature of the Road, while the other gives an overview of the National Road's history.

The anticipated installations will take place starting November 1, 2012. Unveiling ceremonies are in the works. Stay tuned for details!
