## DAR TO PRESERVE HISTORIC MONUMENT

**Indianapolis**—The DAR has partnered with local organizations, and Indiana City Brewing Company to hold a fundraiser for the 1916 Obelisk at the intersection of Southwest Ave and East Washington Street.

The Obelisk was dedicated in 1916 by the DAR to commemorate the State's centennial and mark the intersection of the National Road and the Michigan Road. The Cornelia Cole Fairbanks Chapter of the DAR Chapter, spearheaded by Claire Rutledge, is working to restore the

monument for Indiana's coming bi-centennial.

This event, called "Raise a Pint for the Obelisk," will be held on March 7th, from 2pm-10pm. Indiana City Brewing Co. at 24 Shelby Street is the host. The event includes a silent auction, craft beer, and music. \$1 from every pint sold goes to the cause of restoring the Obelisk.

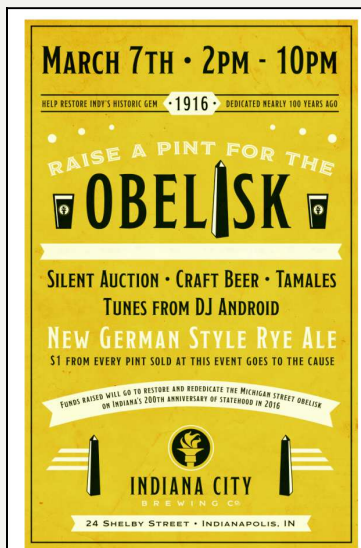
