The celebration lasted from 2:00-4:00pm, and included a first person interpretation of Virginia Meredith by Phyllis Mattheis. Jim and Norma Bertsch hosted tours of the Meredith House.

Several organizations sponsored the marker including the Indiana National Road Association, and Western Wayne Heritage.
