## FAREWELL FROM JOE FROST

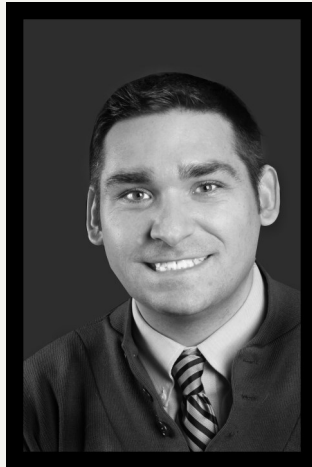
